Asakusa & TOKYO SKYTREE Night Tour

Visit one of Tokyo's must-see destinations, the world's tallest free-standing broadcasting tower, TOKYO SKYTREE. You can enjoy the 300-odd shops and restaurants at the foot of the tower, collectively known as Tokyo Solamachi. This area strives to embrace new trends while preserving the atmosphere of old Tokyo.

Tokyo Tower Night view

Opened in 1958, the 333-meter-high Tokyo Tower is still loved by people as a symbol of Tokyo. It has a 150-meter-high Main Observatory and a 250-meter-high Special Observatory. At night, 180 lights illuminate Tokyo Tower.
